On gun control and school safety, Corrigan said his record has been misrepresented. He said he would have voted to license gun dealers, believes in waiting periods before guns can be purchased and objects to bumpstocks.

"I support the Second Amendment, but with common sense," Corrigan said.

Walker said if hair and nail salons require state licenses, so should gun shops. He recalled serving in combat in Vietnam, saying the kind of gun he car-

ried there was only used to kill people.

Rooney, a former high school teacher, opposed raising the age to own a gun to 21, but said a proposal to arm teachers is "completely ridiculous."

Gillespie would raise the gun purchasing age to 21 and disagrees with arming teachers.


